Fujisawa City Employee Infected with Novel Coronavirus

An employee of the City of Fujisawa who works in Fujisawa Health Center was confirmed to be infected with the novel coronavirus yesterday.

After the test results determined, the Health Center was temporarily closed and inside of its building was disinfected on that day. The Health Center established a tent out of doors and provided consultation and other services for visitors during that time.

The temporary closure of the Health Center might have caused inconvenience to those who visited, but the disinfection work was completed within the day. The Health Center has returned to its normal operation today and the health and hygiene services of the City are not affected.

Amid the declaration of a state of emergency is being issued, there is no doubt that anyone could be infected at anytime and anywhere. Currently, as hand sanitizers are difficult to be obtained, the City starts to distribute weak acidic electrolytic water which has sterilization effect to the citizens at Community Centers and Community Halls from April 16. Please make effective use of this water for the infection prevention.
